REGGIONARRA 2019 Call for proposal dedicated to young storytellers 7th edition

Promoters of the call are Reggio Children Foundation - Loris Malaguzzi Centre in collaboration with the Municipality of Reggio Emilia and the Infant-Toddler Centres and Preschools Istituzione of the Municipality of Reggio Emilia.

Reggionarra 2019 once again proposes a call dedicated to young storytellers who aim to undertake a training together with a collective storytelling experience.

Reggionarra is an event which was created in 2006 from the educational experience of the Municipal Infant-Toddler Centres and Preschools and originates from the storytelling training which parents took part in the educational structures. From the beginning the program was enriched by the contribution of professional storytellers and theatre companies, and since 2013 has also included a section dedicated to storytellers under the age of 35.

The call aims to select 10 young storytellers who will participate in a training course to be held from 13rd – 19th May 2019 in Reggio Emilia during the event Reggionarra.

1. Aims of the course

The purpose of the course is to promote and provide educational opportunities of exchange and comparison for young Italians and foreigners, in order to increase the value of their creativity and narrative skills.

2. Structure of the course

The course consists of lectures, workshops and narrative performances to be held from 13rd – 19th May 2019, for a period of 50 hours, at the *Casa delle Storie*, via Beretti 24/D, Reggio Emilia. The course will conclude with a narrative performance included in the official program of the event.

The training course will be held by Monica Morini and Bernardino Bonzani, actors and directors of the “Teatro dell’Orsa”, with the director and musicologist Antonella Talamonti.

At the end of the course, a certificate of attendance will be issued to participants.

3. Requirements

Applicants should be young Italians and foreign storytellers, aged between 18 and 35 years, who operate in the field of childhood storytelling and/or in the performing arts field (theatre, dance, music, visual languages).

The knowledge of the English language is required for foreign storytellers.

4. Submission of applications

In order to participate in the selection, please send:

- The completed application form (downloadable from the website www.reggionarra.it)
- The link to a video (audiovisual document by camera or mobile phone) that reproduces a storytelling interpreted by the candidate, lasting at least 3 minutes, for boys and girls up to 11 years
- Curriculum vitae (.doc or .pdf format)
- Letter of presentation (.doc or .pdf format)
- Copy of identity card or passport
- Italian Privacy Act form (downloadable from the website www.reggionarra.it)

The applications and the required documentation must be sent by email to reggionarra@reggiochildrenfoundation.org no later than **Midnight on 10th April 2019**.

Incomplete applications, received after the deadline indicated or sent to other email addresses will not be taken into account.

5. Selection of applications

The selection of the candidates will be made by the final judgement of the competent committee with the aim of creating a team characterized by balance among gender, age, nationality and performing languages, with a special focus on innovative qualities and originality of the proposal.

The results of the selection will be published on the website

www.reggionarra.it by **18th April 2019**.

The storytellers selected will be required, under penalty of exclusion, to send confirmation of the participation in the course together with the payment receipt of the registration fee referred to in art.6, **within 30th April 2019**.

6. Terms of participation

The registration fee for the course amounts to € 120,00 and includes the accomodation; payment must be made by *bank transfer to the current account held Fondazione Reggio Children – Centro Loris Malaguzzi - IBAN IT58E0809512800000070121730 – causale (reason for payment): Bando REGGIONARRA 2019 – : iscrizione di.....(name of the participant)*. The registration fee will not be refunded on account of lack of participation in the course or for any other reason beyond the control of the Foundation.

Travel and food costs will be borne by the participants.

7. Processing of personal data

Personal data will be processed by Reggio Children Foundation - Loris Malaguzzi Centre and the Municipality of Reggio Emilia, in compliance with Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 on the protection of personal data, for the unique purpose of participating in the selection of this public competition. Personal data may be used as documentary material to inform about the activities and initiatives related to the event “Reggionarra 2019” and following editions.

Data are processed both on paper and computer; their provision is required in order to participate in the selection.

The data controllers are Reggio Children Foundation - Loris Malaguzzi Centre and the Municipality of Reggio Emilia.

Reggio Children Foundation - Loris Malaguzzi Centre and Municipality of Reggio Emilia can use the images and video material sent for the call for proposal dedicated to young storytellers, for the communication and promotion of the event “Reggionarra 2019” (publications, brochures, headline boards, Internet, catalogue etc.) and for other non-profit printed or telematic publications, aimed at documenting the activity of the Reggio Children Foundation - Loris Malaguzzi Centre and Municipal Administration.
